Strategies in Court and how to always win - Part 1

This article discusses how to prepare yourself to win in front of any judge.

Before you think about any strategy, it is really important to think well and deeply about all the concepts described in my previous papers about the 'person', 'ownership' and how the legal system deceives us. You might also want to read my book to comprehend the entire picture.

Before you do anything or formulate strategies to use in court, the knowledge that I present to you **must** be ingrained in you and you also **must** have a level of comprehension and conviction to go into court knowing what you are doing.

Not to worry, as anything else, it can be learned, comprehended and made part of you.

This is necessary, because if that knowledge somehow is not yet part of you, old patterns might kick in and your chances to be successful in court greatly diminish.

This is because our indoctrination and the way we have been educated is strongly biased towards obeying any sort of authority. We have been intimidated by authority figures all our lives and the problem with that is that it is natural to us.

When we see an individual in a robe in court it is quite intimidating. When we see a cop on the street it is intimidating. When we see an individual in a white coat in a hospital it is quite intimidating. It changes our behavior and old patterns automatically start to kick in. Fear and wonder is a very powerful combination that any judge uses to his or her advantage. If you are not prepared or lack the necessary conviction, you will loose.

When fear is at play, lots of emotions will crop up and the ability to think clearly and approach the situation objectively, will become very difficult. Things you think you know will go out the window and only raw instinct will remain.

That instinct has been well polished by the people in power to keep you subservient and chances are great that you will behave like you always have behaved. So to be prepared you have to work on this knowledge and make it part of you. That is de-programming yourself and observing your mind at all times.

It is all this indoctrination in our head that we are really fighting against and that is why it takes time to absorb the knowledge of my book and the previous articles.

It is truly important to sit with it, re-think it, contemplate it, re-read it, put it in the right context of all the relevant events that happened in your life.

It is also important to start seeing where you have been deceived by the illusion and where you were actually in reality.

All of your education and indoctrination has been done by design.

You will only be ready when you can actually **separate** the illusion from reality. That is the key. It is the main primer for you to be successful. It is your ability to separate illusion and reality that will bring you victory in court.

When you can see the deception in its entirety and comprehend everything that is happening in court, then you will be able to have control over the situation.

Please realize that everything that happens in court starts with you as a living being and ends with you. The legal system **needs** you to be there physically as a **living being** and it needs you to **act as if** you are a **fictional being**.

That is the very first moment the illusion starts, when the legal system tries to pull you in. Whatever you do, just do not let that happen. **Do not act** as if you are the person and you will win.

The moment you have full control over what is real and what is illusionary, you will be ready.

Theater

Every time in court, realize that the whole legal system is fictional. It is not real.

Look around you. What do you see? It's a fancy building, with rooms and lots of people walking around. Some of them are dressed in black robes and others are not. The reality is that it is just a building with people, nothing more. That is the stage.

The people walking around all act out a role, which is also not real. They are the actors. And you happen to walk around because you have an issue there. Either you were 'summoned to appear' or you were dragged there.

You happen to have business there with the owner of the jurisdiction. That owner is the judge. It is just a living individual, just like you or me, who dresses in a robe and talks a legal language to try to impress and intimidate you.

That judge is just an actor on stage, acting out an illusion, through which he or she tries to get jurisdiction and control over **you**. No matter what happens, do not let the judge have jurisdiction over you.

You can achieve this by **never ever** appearing as the person on your identity card. In other words never act as if you **are** that person. You are real, the person is fake. So it means you **never ever** acknowledge that you are that person on the ID card.

The courts, but also other agents in society try to get three things from you:

- 1. The legal name of your person
- 2. The birth date of your person
- 3. The address where your person lives

Look at the wording of the three points above carefully. I am not talking about you. I am talking about your person. Your person is **not** you. Almost all people would confirm the above three points **as if** it would be their information. 'Their' name, 'their' birth date and 'their' address. You see the problem here? They have equated two things that are not equal. They have equated the living individual and the person as **one**.

Your goal in court is to keep the living individual and the person separate.

If you give them the above three points **as if** it were information about you as the living individual, you would have instantaneously **lost**. You would have given the judge jurisdiction over you and whatever you say, the judge will decide your fate.

In that case you just have accepted to **contract** with the judge and there is no way back: the system and especially the judge will have full jurisdiction and control over you. This is because you **consented** to enter into a contract with whoever asked you for the above three points. That is how it works.

Of course, anytime you give anybody your ID, you also enter into a contract with the legal fiction which is represented by the individual who is asking for your ID. Some ID do not have the home address where the person lives, but the ID is **enough** to enter into any form of contract when you hand it over to the agent of the system who is asking for it.

Be very careful what you give to anyone.

When you refuse to give those three points, or refuse to give your ID and also declare that you wish not to contract with them and that you do not consent to

their terms, they **cannot** and **will not** touch you. In this case they cannot establish authority over you, because you refuse to enter into contract with them. It is that simple.

You might be taken into custody, but I assure you, they will let you go. That custody is nothing more than kidnapping, because you have not agreed to contract with them. Use that against them. Hold your ground. Eventually, they will let you go through the back door so nobody sees what happened. That is how they keep the theater a secret.

Never talk to anybody, but the judge

Before you get to court, remember that there is a lengthy process of all kinds of antics to get you to fall for the deception.

There is the police who picks you up from your home or off the street. There are also special investigators who try to get information from you. There is perhaps border or customs personnel who intimidate you with all kinds of rules and regulations. There is all kinds of agents who work for the system that do the due diligence to have you trapped by the system. Realize it is all theater, whether the agents realize it themselves or not. Keep it real and do not fall for their threats.

All that information that is gathered by the agents is for one person only: **the owner**. And that is **the judge**. The country is the real owner, albeit fictional, so the judge works on behalf of the country and is bestowed with the power **as if** the judge **were** the owner.

In other words, on behalf of the country, the judge **wields** the power of the **owner**.

All that due diligence of all those agents ends up with the owner, the judge. It is important to note that no cop, investigator, special agents, customs representative or any other agent of the system owns anything. None of them own anything. They are just servants to the country. They cannot decide your fate.

Only one individual can decide your fate and that is the **judge**.

So my question to you would be: why would you want to talk to agents who do not own anything and cannot decide your fate anyway? Why weaken your case by revealing too much information and giving them a head start against you?

Just ignore all the crime series you have watched on TV and just remember this simple rule: **Never ever** talk to anybody, **but** the judge.

Insist to every agent that you want to talk to the judge and nobody else. Insist that you will not answer any questions. You will keep the initiative and have them stunned by your resolution. It also starts a case in court fairly: The judge will know nothing of you, just as you do not know anything about them. It is an even playground. It is fair. Let the theater begin.

Never sign anything with anyone

If you keep your resolution to never talk to anyone but the judge, this point follows logically from the whole previous section: **Never ever** sign anything with **any** agent before you are sitting in front of a judge.

Anything you sign will be used against you, but the worst thing is: If you sign something you will have acknowledged the legal system and you will have appeared as the person. This is because the person is a dead being. You, the living individual, would have signed **for** the person, on its behalf. This rule holds for **anything** you sign. So do not sign anything.

The person is fictional, so the person cannot do anything, it's not real. **You** have to sign **for** the person, to give it **life**, to have it recognized in court. When you sign something, you **act as if** you **are** the person.

Never take an attorney

The attorney is another fictitious being that acts on behalf of your person.

The living being that acts out the role of the attorney uses his/her own person to speak on behalf of your person in matters concerning your person.

It is quite obvious that if you choose to use an attorney, that you have recognized the legal system and that you will not be able to defend yourself as a living being.

You will be treated as a person and the judge will have the power to do whatever the judge likes with you. An attorney will never change anything in that. Even worse, any attorney is a member of the bar association or a similar organization depending on the jurisdiction where you live, so **any** attorney works indirectly for the **owner**. You can see that having an attorney is a **trap**. It is the worst move you can ever make to use an attorney.

This is also because you cannot defend yourself and you cannot expose the lies and the deception. Somebody else is speaking for you, and thus instead of you. That living being, acting as your attorney, will most likely have no clue about what is written in this article or in my book and will singlehandedly make sure that your chances to defeat the system reduces to absolute zero.

The consequence is that you will have no control over your fate and no chance to expose the deception. **Never** ever use an attorney.

It is better to educate yourself, write a strategy and no matter what happens, to be standfast on your conviction. It is better to realize that you are dealing with an illusion and that the person and the affairs in court are not real.

You will need to defend your physical body with all your might and always know if you are working in reality or in fiction. Again, that is **THE** key. Always be on alert if you are working in reality or in fiction.

Digest this information first and reflect on it, before you move to part 2 of strategies in court.
